2023-2024 Parish Grant Application

A Parish Grant Application is necessary for each family at St. Regis Academy who is seeking a Parish Grant.

A completed Parish Grant Application is required BEFORE being considered for the discounted rate.

This form needs to be submitted with the St. Regis Academy Application Form by March 30th. Quarterly verification of active Parish participation is required. By meeting the guidelines listed below, as verified by your Parish, families are considered active participating parishioners and qualify to receive a Parish Grant.

1. Parish Registration/Sunday Mass Attendance

The family must be registered in their parish and attend Mass weekly. Children should be encouraged to worship in a parish faith community on Sundays in order to understand that they are nourished in faith at the parish celebration of the Eucharist.

2. Active Parish Participation/Ministry

In order for a vibrant parish to continue to carry out its ministry, it is essential that all members participate in various ministry and volunteering opportunities within the parish. This provides another chance for our young people to see the close connection between faith and service.

3. Stewardship/Financial Contribution

The financial support of any parish is also crucial for its overall growth and ministry. While all families are blessed differently, our faith teaches that we are all blessed by God and called to share according to our means. A family receiving Active Catholic tuition rates must contribute to your parish by the use of Sunday envelopes. Even a modest amount, expresses gratitude to God for the gifts we have received and returns a portion to Him to help build the kingdom through ministry. Using the Sunday envelopes also models sharing and generosity to children and can encourage formative stewardship discussions.

The goal of these guidelines is to provide a solid foundation for Catholic education in our community. We have been entrusted with the responsibility of raising our children in the practice of the faith. Together we can meet the challenge of providing both a strong Catholic school education and vibrant parishes in which our children mature in faith, hope, and love.

Parish leaders, i.e. Pastor, Deacons, Business Manager, reserve the right to determine these grants on behalf of the Parish. Grants will be issued in 2 parts. Part 1 will be applied on December 1st and Part 2 will be applied on April 1st. Grants may vary in amount, but unlikely to exceed \$250.
